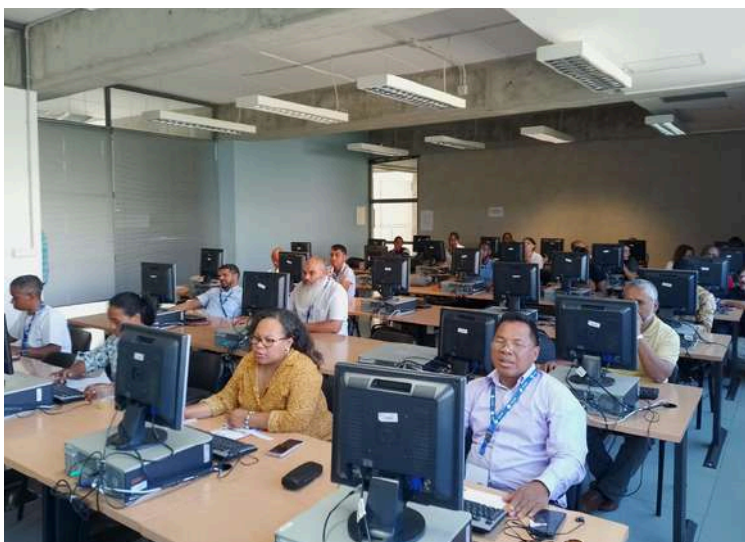


What is DigItAfrica?
